

2021 STACK HOUSE Cabernet Sauvignon Sonoma County

92 POINTS – THE WINE PALATE

Deep garnet-purple colored, black cherries and blackcurrant jelly notes leap from the glass, leading to spicy suggestions of clove oil, anise, and Sichuan pepper. The full-bodied palate shimmers with bright, bold fruit, supported by soft tannins and just enough freshness, finishing long and spicy. 5/25

91 POINTS – JEB DUNNUCK

Black and blue fruits, currants, darker chocolate, and ripe berry notes all emerge from the 2021 Cabernet Sauvignon Stack House. Based on 84% Cabernet Sauvignon, 8% Petit Verdot, and 8% Petite Sirah, it's ripe and deeply hued, with a broad, layered texture and ripe tannins. Drink this beautiful wine over the coming 7-8 years. 3/2025

The 2021 Stack House Sonoma County Cabernet Sauvignon bursts from the glass with intense aromas of black currants, blackberries and black cherries. Savory layers of roasted herbs, crushed volcanic rock, licorice, spice, espresso roast and toasty oak continue to emerge and waft from the glass. This Cabernet Sauvignon coats the palate with a generous mouthfeel and exhibits great overall tannin structure and weight. The finish is powerful and enduring.
