

2019 M.A. MONTICELLI BAROLO

From a great vintage for the region, the 2019 Barolo has a deeper, richer style while staying classic Nebbiolo with its elegance and purity. Mulled cherries, rose petals, licorice, and spicy, leathery nuances all define the aromatics, and it's medium-bodied and silky, with incredible balance. 3/7/24

92 POINTS – THE WINE INDEPENDENT

The 2019 M.A. Monticelli Barolo is pale ruby-purple in color. It needs a little swirling to set loose a gorgeous perfume of kirsch, redcurrant jelly, and rose oil, with hints of charcoal, truffles, and fragrant earth. The medium-bodied palate has a rock-solid structure of firm, grainy tannins and bold freshness supporting the vibrant red fruits, finishing long and earthy. 4/13/23

The M.A. Monticelli Barolo offers seductive aromas of wild berry, red cherry and raspberry compote followed by hints of dried rose petals, forest brush, tobacco, wood and spice. The palate is soft, supple and framed with beautifully structured tannins. This Barolo exhibits balanced acidity and gorgeous finesse. This wine benefits from decanting and continues to unfold gracefully in the glass.
