

# 2021 M.A. MONTICELLI BAROLO

## 95 POINTS – THE WINE PALATE

*Pale ruby colored, the 2021 Barolo springs from the glass with vivacious notes of red cherries and black raspberries, followed by hints of licorice, charcoal, and black pepper with a waft of lilacs. Full-bodied, the palate is tightly wound with perfumed red berry flavors, framed by chalky tannins and great tension, finishing long and fragrant.*

*The M.A. Monticelli Barolo offers seductive aromas of wild berry, red cherry and raspberry compote followed by hints of dried rose petals, forest brush, tobacco, wood and spice. The palate is soft, supple and framed with beautifully structured tannins. This Barolo exhibits balanced acidity and gorgeous finesse. This wine benefits from decanting and continues to unfold gracefully in the glass.*
