

# 2021 M.A. MONTICELLI LANGHE NEBBIOLO

## 91 POINTS – JEB DUNNUCK

*A smoking value, the 2021 Nebbiolo (100% Nebbiolo) has a light ruby hue to go with classic notes of bright cherries, dried rose, and sappy herb nuances. This medium-bodied, elegant, balanced beauty will shine on the dinner table. 3/7/24*

## 90 POINTS – THE WINE INDEPENDENT

*Pale ruby-purple in color, the single-varietal 2021 Nebbiolo Langhe sashays out of the glass with showy notes of fresh raspberries and Bing cherries followed by hints of rose petals, charcoal, and wild sage plus a touch of aniseed. The medium-bodied palate is lightly chewy and lively, with vivacious red berry flavors and a lingering anise-laced finish. 3/28/24*

*The M.A. Monticelli Langhe Nebbiolo explodes from the glass with aromas of ripe cherries, wild raspberries, blackberries, perfumed lavender and baking spice. This soft and approachable wine has a gorgeous fruit-forward nose and plush tannins on the palate. 50% of the grapes for this wine come from the Barolo designation lending beautiful structure to the palate.*
