

2022 M.A. MONTICELLI ROERO ARNEIS

91 POINTS – JEB DUNNUCK

Beautiful dried herbs, chalky minerality, and pretty citrus-like fruits all define the 2022 Arneis, a balanced, medium-bodied, crisp, and undeniably delicious white to drink over the coming couple of years. 3/7/24

91 POINTS – THE WINE INDEPENDENT

Notes of lime leaves, wet slate, and green apples slowly emerge from the glass of the single-varietal 2022 Roero Arneis, with a touch of blanched almonds. The medium-bodied palate is vibrant and refreshing, with a long zesty finish. 3/28/24

The M.A. Monticelli Roero Arneis generously wafts from the glass with aromatics of white peaches, pears, orange blossoms, mandarins and lemon rind. The palate exhibits nice viscosity while maintaining freshness. Flavors of honeysuckle and marzipan on the palate combined with a long-lasting finish showcase the complexity of this beautiful Northern Italian white wine.
