

2017 M.A. MONTICELLI BAROLO

The M.A. Monticelli Barolo offers seductive aromas of wild berry, red cherry and raspberry compote followed by hints of dried rose petals, forest brush, tobacco, wood and spice. The palate is soft, supple and framed with beautifully structured tannins. This Barolo exhibits balanced acidity and gorgeous finesse. This wine benefits from decanting and continues to unfold gracefully in the glass.

There are a scant 100 cases of the 2017 Barolo, another pretty, medium-bodied, elegant wine offering textbook cherry, flowers, and cedary spice-driven aromas and flavors. It has some savory tannins, good balance, and outstanding length. Drink it any time over the coming 10-12 years, if not more. 3/10/22.
