94 POINTS – THE WINE PALATE

The 2023 Cabernet Sauvignon includes 9% Malbec in the blend and spent 19 months in French oak barrels, 75% new. Deep garnet-purple colored, it races out with vibrant notes of fresh blackberries and black currants, leading to hints of raspberries, menthol, and pencil shavings. The full-bodied palate delivers a suggestion of toasty oak to complement the bright black and red berry flavors, supported by firm, grainy tannins and bags of freshness, finishing on a persistent minty note.

93 POINTS – JEB DUNNUCK

Based on 91% Cabernet Sauvignon and 9% Malbec, aged in 100% French oak (75% new), the 2023 Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley offers darker currants, smoky tobacco, chocolate, and hints of spice in a deeper purple-hued, medium to full-bodied package. It's concentrated, has a layered mid-palate, ripe tannins, and a great finish. With roughly 1,250 cases produced, this is another brilliant wine that can be enjoyed any time over the coming decade. Drink 2025-2035.

The 2023 Tether Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon possesses gorgeous aromas of ripe blackberries, black currants and black cherries. Layers of crushed rock, spices, chocolate and espresso roast dance out of the glass. The oak integration is seamless, contributing warmth and spice without overwhelming the fruit core. The wine is full-bodied and exhibits a rich plushness on the palate couples with structured yet approachable tannins. The Tether Cabernet showcases incredible length, elegance and power on the palate and culminates in a long satisfying finish.
